Merit Scholarships

Christian Heritage Academy is pleased to offer four \$5000 CHA Upper School Merit Scholarships, to be disbursed over four years. The scholarships were established to recognize three teachers and one staff for two decades or more of outstanding service to the Academy in four areas.



The Jeff Cook Athletic Merit Scholarship will be awarded to a student applicant entering ninth grade who has shown solid Christian character as well as exceptional leadership and skill in athletics.



The Janis Kahren Servant Heart Merit Scholarship will be awarded to a student applicant entering ninth grade who has shown solid Christian character as well as the desire to serve others selflessly and to do “whatever it takes” to accomplish a task with excellence.



The Pam Magary Fine Arts Merit Scholarship will be awarded to a student applicant entering ninth grade who has shown solid Christian character as well as an exceptional interest and ability in fine arts.



The Robin Russell Science, Math and Technology Merit Scholarship will be awarded to a student applicant entering ninth grade who has shown solid Christian character as well as an exceptional interest and ability in the areas of science, math and/or technology.

Merit Scholarship Application Guidelines

1. Applicant must have been admitted to CHA Upper School.
2. Applicant must submit the following three-part application by January 31 prior to freshman year.
 - Part 1: A two-page typed essay stating which merit scholarship the applicant is applying for, and why the applicant qualifies to receive the award
 - Part 2: A portfolio with documents supporting Part 1 (e.g. grade transcript, DVD, listing of awards and honors, commendations, photographs of projects)
 - Part 3: A letter of reference written by an adult (non-family member) with direct personal knowledge of the applicant over time and in the areas related to the scholarship
3. The Merit Scholarship will be disbursed as a tuition credit over the four years of high school and the recipient's status will be reviewed annually.
4. All applicants will be notified by letter and/or email by March 1 prior to freshman year.
